## **Instructions for Filing an Annual Business Return**

(Form 28)

Under Part XXIV of The Corporations Act



A trust corporation, loan corporation, extra-provincial trust corporation or extra-provincial loan corporation must file an Annual Business Return (Form 28) within 90 days after the end of its fiscal year.

A late filing fee of \$ 200.00 per day will be assessed if the Annual Business Return is received after the 90-day period allowed.

The following instructions are for specific sections of the form. Please type or print.

- 1. The Manitoba Corporation number is the Registry number provided on the Certificate of Registration issued by Manitoba Companies Office.
- 4. Include an address for the attorney for service. Manitoba incorporated trust and loan corporations should mark this "N/A".
- 6. For each new director attach information on other directorships held, and on whether the director is affiliated with the corporation. When a director is an officer, employee or shareholder of the corporation or of a body corporate that is a shareholder of the corporation the director is affiliated with the corporation.
- 9. Provide a copy of any changes made to the by-laws of the corporation since the last Annual Business Return was filed.
  - (c) The corporate organization chart should show all affiliated bodies corporate.
  - (d) A fee of \$5,000.00 must accompany the Annual Business Return. Make your cheque payable to the Minister of Finance of Manitoba. Payments can also be made by Electronic Fund Transfer (please see enclosed instructions).
- The Annual Business Return must be signed by the proper officer(s).

In addition to this Annual Business Return, an annual return must be filed with the Companies Office.
